Guidelines for Recipient Organizations and/or Programs:

1. Organization falls into one of the "Charitable Giving Categories" listed.

2. Organization is a registered nonprofit organization, and contributions are tax-deductible under the Internal Revenue Code.
3. Organization is not a political organization, a campaign for public office, or an organization whose primary purpose is to influence legislation.
4. Organization does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, sexual orientation, national origin, age, disability, or veteran's status.
5. Organization may be religious in nature, but services provided to its recipients should not have "strings attached." In other words, not mandated to attend religious services as a condition of receiving food, treatment services, or shelter.
6. Donation is not in exchange for any good or services.
7. Donation is not for school projects that are not curriculum-related.
8. Donation is not for any kind of contest, trip or tour.

Charitable Giving Categories:

1. Human Assistance: Organizations with survival in mind. These organizations provide food, shelter, clothing, transportation, life enhancement, and/or mental health services.
2. Community Development: Organizations that provide enhancements to our community.
3. Education: Organizations that promote education in all forms, and for all age groups, and who improve the skills of the community as a whole.
4. Youth Activities: Organizations that improve the safety & quality of life for the youth.
