Holiday Skip-a-Pay & Loans



To help combat the extra holiday stress, we will once again be offering our members access to the Holiday Skip-a-Pay Program. This program will allow you extra tme to extend your existing loan contract.

You can chose to skip 1 (one) monthly payment, 2 (two) biweekly payments, or 4 (four) weekly payments during November, December or January. The fee for this program is \$25 per loan. Extension agreements can be picked up at any branch or printed from our website. Your loan must be paid current to qualify. This program excludes payments on Mortgages, Home Equity Loans & Lines of Credit, and CD/Share Secured Loans.

Another way to help manage holiday costs is with a low interest rate Holiday Loan. Avoid making holiday purchases on high-interest rate credit cards with a quick and easy in-house loan process.
